Residential or Business Alarm Systems

Alarm Permits – City Ordinance requires all residence and business alarm systems, whether monitored or audible, be registered with the Blue Springs Police Department. An application for an Alarm User Permit can be downloaded from the www.bluespringsgov.com and returned to the Alarm Permit Division by mail, fax (228-0242), or in person. Permit numbers are assigned for the purpose of tracking false alarms. Failure to obtain a permit could result in the issuance of a General Ordinance Summons, which requires a court appearance and could result in payment of a fine.

If you have a false alarm at your home/business, immediately contact your monitoring company and give them your access code so that they won't dispatch police. If the alarm company has already contacted the police, request that they cancel the police response. It is the alarm user's responsibility to investigate and correct the cause of a false alarm. If the police arrive before you cancel, you will be charged with a false alarm if, in fact, it is false.

Anytime there are changes in the original information we have on file, the Police Department needs to be contacted as soon as possible with the changes.

You will need to submit an updated application:

- If you switch to another alarm monitoring company
- If you should move to another location in Blue Springs
- If you should move out of Blue Springs
- If your phone number and/or responsible parties should change
- Also if you replace your door, replacement stickers are available
