Bubble Ball Rental Rules and Terms of Use

All participants and guests must adhere to the rules and regulations of the Blue Springs Fieldhouse and those listed on this document. Players will be responsible for the damage to the bubbles or other players' bubbles if found to have caused intentional damage at any time to their or other players' bubbles.

Rental

- Rental requests must be made at least one (1) week in advance.
- All participants must complete a waiver. Youth under the age of 18 will need a signature from a legal guardian.
- A completed facility rental request form is required with every bubble ball rental.
- Payment is due at the time of booking.
- Security deposits are refundable following your rental. Please allow 1-2 weeks for processing. Deposits are forfeit with cancellation or damage of bubbles.
- All participants and guests must remain in the area reserved during the time of your rental. Guests are welcome to use the facility before and/or after the rental with active membership check-in or purchase of a day pass.

Prepare to Play

- Have long hair tied up and remove jewelry.
- Sharp objects cannot be worn while inside the bubble.
- Please empty your pockets. We will not be responsible for lost items – please securely store any personal objects inside the available lockers.
- Tennis shoes only. No cleats.
- No large belt buckles that could damage the bubble or injure the player.

Play

- Participants must be at least 14 years old to use a bubble ball.
- Play can consist of 6 to 10 players – teams of 3, 4 or 5.
- Shoulder straps must be securely fastened over the participants' shoulders at all times.
- Players must hold onto bubble ball handles at all times while inside the bubble.
- Contact between players can only be made when both players are playing the ball. No blindsiding or colliding with another player who is not actively playing the ball.
- Tennis shoes must be worn at all times. No cleats.
- Players must remain in the bubble ball at all times during play.
- Play must stop immediately when the whistle is blown.
- No diving at other players.

Activities that May Result in a Foul or Possible Eviction of the Game

- Intentional contact with shoes to the bubbles.
- Contact with another player when they are facing the opposite direction or while on the ground
- Use of profanity during the game
- Intentional repeat attack of another player
- Use of excessive force towards another player
